### Evidence 17: "Cabinet Minister's Day" From *Punch* Almanac for 1910



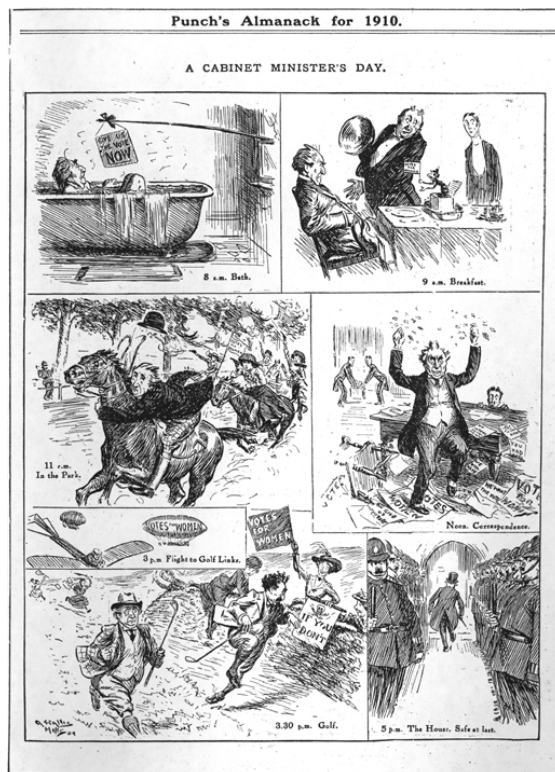
#### Introduction
